

Guidelines for Student Service Learning Credit (2009-2010)

Students who participate in BGES PTA sponsored activities with the goal of earning SSL hours agree to the following requirements:

- Students shall be on time for activity.
- Students are responsible for providing their own copy of the SSL Verification Form.
- Unless excused by supervisor, students shall stay until end of activity.
- Students shall be prepared for the task they have volunteered for (this includes appropriate dress, and having eaten meals prior to attending event.)
- Student participation in PTA activity for SSL credit must be authorized prior to the event. Exceptions may only be made at the discretion of the event supervisor.
- Student shall treat **all** others (adults and children) with respect.
- Cell phone use is **prohibited** (exceptions may be made by activity supervisor.)
- Profanity is absolutely prohibited.
- Students working with children shall conduct themselves appropriately and responsibly. (This means supervising, not participating in, activities and being attentive to the children.)
- Students may not order food or eat in front of the children they are supervising. (This requirement is meant to address any potential food allergy issues. If necessary, the activity supervisor can plan meal breaks for volunteers for activities that occur during meal times.)

I have read the above guidelines and agree to abide by them. The activity supervisor shall determine whether I complied with these guidelines prior to signing the SSL Verification Form.
