- Reflect on the theme "**Diversity Means...**" and create an original work of art.
- Fill out the Student Entry Form and Consent Form that must accompany each entry. These forms can be found on the CHS PTSA Website. The entry form must be filled out electronically, printed and then signed.
- Turn in your Artwork, the Student Entry Form and the Consent Form (if necessary) to the Main Office on the **deadline Monday, October 24, 2011** (*please note that all visual arts entries should be wrapped for their protection*).
- Share your artwork and earn recognition at the Reflections Gallery and Awards Ceremony during the November 14, 2011 PTSA meeting at Clarksburg High School.
