It is recommended that supplies be placed in a large school supply box that will fit in a desk (with a 4 inch tall opening). - 6 notebook dividers (Math, Reading, Science, Social Studies, Writing, Grammar)
- 1 zipper pouch with holes for the binder
- 12 #2 pencils for the entire school year
- 1 2-inch personal binder
- 2 personal composition books for math & writing
- 1 plastic pocket folder with holes for homework
- 1 pair of headphones for Chromebook use
