Academic Progress Reports

Today students received their second quarter progress reports. During this second quarter all grade levels will continue with reading and math instruction. In grade 3 instruction focuses on measurement, computation, facts and estimation strategies, number theories and properties. In math, students will learn how to estimate & measure length; convert between inches, feet & yards; estimate & count to find perimeter, area, and volume of figures & objects; write a story problem that models a mathematical expression; model & explain multiplication & division in a variety of ways; use estimation techniques to determine solutions to problems with whole numbers. The reading focus is Reading for Information and Reading for Literary Experience. Unlike literary text, students will learn how to choose important from the text; distinguish between cause and effect; identify topic sentence & supporting details when summarizing; identify text features & how they help to make meaning of the text.
