

To Earn the IB Diploma Students must complete:

- One course and assessment in each of 6 subject areas
 - 3 courses at Higher Level (HL)
 - 3 courses at Standard Level (SL)
 - maximum of 2 SL exams in junior year
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course and TOK essay
- Extended Essay
- Creativity, Action, Service (CAS)

IB Course options

Group 1 - English HL - 2-year course - taken in junior and senior years

Group 2 – Second Language

Spanish – SL or HL or *ab initio*

French – SL or HL or *ab initio*

SL – can test in the junior or senior year at level 5, 6, or 7

HL - can test in the senior year at level 6 or 7

ab initio SL – can test in the senior year at level 3 only

Group 3 – Individuals and Society

History HL

2-year course taken in junior and senior years

Informational Technology in a Global Society (ITGS)

SL - 1 year course - junior or senior year

HL - 2 year course – junior and senior years

Group 4 – Experimental Sciences

Chemistry - SL

1-year course - junior or senior year

Physics – SL or HL

2-year course – junior and senior years - choose SL or HL exam in senior year

Biology – HL

Double blocked class in senior year

Group 5 – Mathematics

Math Studies - SL

1-year course - junior or senior year

Mathematics – SL *register for IB pre-calculus*

2-year course – IB Pre-calculus and AP Calculus BC

Mathematics – HL – calculus is a pre-requisite

2-year course -

Group 6 – The Arts

As a 6th subject, students can take a group 6 class or a second subject from groups 2, 3, or 4 (see above)

Music – SL or HL - prerequisite Music Theory or approval of Ms. Rackey

2-year course – junior and senior years - choose SL or HL exam in senior year

Theatre Arts – SL or HL

2-year course – junior and senior years - choose SL or HL exam in senior year

Visual Arts – SL or HL

2-year course – junior and senior years - choose SL or HL exam in senior year

Transdisciplinary

Environmental Systems and Societies – SL – counts as Group 3 and/or 4

1-year course - junior or senior year

TOK/Extended Essay

TOK I – Semester A of junior year

TOK II – Semester A of senior year

Extended Essay – Semester B of Junior year
