

Attention All Grade 2 Parents!

Flower Hill Elementary School is in the process of gathering information about second grade students in order to provide each child with challenging instruction in third grade. This process is known as Global Screening. During the week of February 8th, all Grade 2 students in Montgomery County Public Schools will be assessed on two subtests of the InView. The InView is an assessment of cognitive abilities. Each subtest takes approximately 25 minutes to complete. **Grade 2 students at Flower Hill Elementary will begin the screening process on Monday, February 8, 2010.** Over the next few months we will continue gathering information about each student from a variety of sources, including parents.

In March, parents of Grade 2 students will receive an important survey in the mail. Spanish, Chinese, Vietnamese, Korean, and French translated copies of this survey are available at school.

A parent is a child's first teacher. You have the opportunity to observe your child in a different setting and may notice special skills or qualities that may or may not be seen in the classroom. Information about your child from you is very valuable and we will consider it carefully during the Global Screening process. **Please return the completed survey to school within one week of receiving it in the mail.**
