

DRESSING AND GROOMING (for *students & staff*)

Students and staff are expected to dress in manner which supports an appropriate educational learning environment. Shoes must be worn at all times. Clothing should be worn so that no undergarments are visible. Students may not wear items such as bandannas, pajamas, spaghetti strap tops (at least 1”), under shirts, short skirts (when the arms are extended to the side, the skirt must be beyond the finger tips), short shorts (finger tip rule), hats leggings with a top shorter than finger tip length, sweatbands, slippers, or head coverings except as part of religious observances. Clothing that is extremely tight/revealing is not permitted.

Outer garments such as coats, jackets, vests, and/or gloves may not be worn while in the building. School personnel may advise students about appropriate dress and grooming for school.

Students may not wear clothing that:

- endangers health or safety to self or others.
- promotes the use of alcohol, tobacco, or drugs or other illegal items.
- is lewd, vulgar, obscene, revealing, or of a sexual nature.
- is associated with gangs.
- fails to meet a reasonable requirement of a course or activity.
- causes disruption to the educational environment.
- is likely to cause a disruption to the educational environment.
