

# Dress Code for Students

Students are expected to dress in a manner which supports an appropriate educational learning environment. Dress and grooming are the responsibility of students and their parents/guardians except in situations where the standard of dress is a reasonable requirement of a course or activity or is necessary for reasons of health and safety. Shoes must be worn at all times.

**Students may not wear items such as:**

- **Bandannas**
- **Pajamas**
- **Spaghetti strap tops ( at least one inch wide is required)**
- **under shirts**
- **short skirts (when the arms are extended to the side, the skirt must be beyond the finger tips)**
- **hats**
- **scarves**
- **sweatbands**
- **slippers**
- **shoes with “rollers,” bags on the back in building ( to include the small, string backpacks)**
- **head coverings, except as part of religious observances.**

**Outer garments such as coats, jackets, vests, and/or gloves may not be worn while in the building.** School personnel may advise students about appropriate dress and grooming for school.

**Student may not wear clothing that:**

- Endangers the health or safety of self or others
- Promotes the use of alcohol, tobacco, and/or drugs or other illegal items
- Is lewd, vulgar, obscene, revealing, or of a sexual nature
- Is associated with gangs
- Fails to meet a reasonable requirement of a course or activity
- Causes disruption to the educational environment
- Is likely to cause a disruption to the educational environment
