What will Pre-K Students Learn this Quarter?

Math: Counting 1-5, Matching, Sorting

What will we learn?

- Name the numbers 1-5 in sequence,
- Count the number of objects in a group 1-3,
- Match number symbols 1-3 to groups of objects,
- Match objects that are the same, Identify objects that are different,
- Classify by color, size, shape, number, or other properties.

Why are we learning this?

- To count with understanding and recognize "how many" in sets of objects,
- To connect number words and numerals to the quantities they represent,
- To identify similarities and differences.

How will we learn these things?

- Number rhymes,
- Fingerplay,
- Match pictures and objects to number symbols,
- Identify and describe objects of different colors, textures, and sizes,
- Compare, match, and sort objects based on color, size, or texture.
