What is it?

“Summer Adventures in Learning” is a Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) ELO program designed to help children entering kindergarten through Grade 5 improve their reading, writing, and mathematics skills. The program will reinforce what children already know and will provide a head start on learning for the upcoming school year.

*****Breakfast and lunch will be provided to all students attending.** Bus transportation to Sligo-Dennis Fun Center will be provided after school but a separate form must be filled out for this additional program.

When is it?

The program will run from July 6 through July 31, 2009, for four hours each weekday morning. The program will run from 8:15 a.m. to 12:15 p.m.

Where is it?

The month-long program will be available at Glen Haven Elementary School to Glen Haven students registered at the school for the 2009-2010 school year.

Who can participate?

Students who will be entering kindergarten, first, second, third, fourth or fifth grade in August 2009 and who are enrolled at Glen Haven may participate in the program offered at this school.
