



Meadow Hall's
School-Wide Positive Behavior
High Five System

1. First week of school: Teaching students the system
 - a. On the first day of school, teachers inform their classes of the High Five System (throughout the school day the class will have a chance to earn high fives). The teacher encourages students to see how many High Fives they can earn in the first week of school, which will be counted on Friday and the class will have a surprise reward.
 - b. On the Friday of the first week of school, each class has a 15 minute party. The class fills in the first bar on the graph, sets the next goal, and votes on the next reward (i.e. As soon as our class earns 50 High Fives, we will have a 15 minute popcorn party).
 - c. The graph is posted in the hallway by the classroom door.

2. Encouraging positive school behaviors throughout the school year
 - a. Throughout the day, each class has a chance to earn High Fives throughout the school building when the majority of the students in the class are following Meadow Hall's High Five rules. The following areas are designated times to earn High Fives:
 - i. At the end of lunch by cafeteria staff.
 - ii. At the end of recess by playground monitors.
 - iii. At the end of specials by special area teachers.
 - iv. At the end of an assembly by classroom teachers.
 - v. While traveling in the hallway by staff.
 - vi. During morning line-up by staff.
 - vii. In classrooms, determined by teachers.
 - b. All staff can "catch" classes following the High Five Rules throughout the school day by either giving them a High Five or telling the classroom teacher to give them a High Five.
 - c. As classes receive High Fives throughout the school day, students place the High Fives in a box located in their classrooms.
 - d. At the end of the day, the teacher or student helper counts the High Fives and fills in the graph. Teachers review the progress on the graph.
 - e. High Fives can be "recycled" in the main office.
 - f. When classes reach their goal, the classroom teachers inform the office announce their accomplishment the next morning.
