## **PHILOSOPHY**

The staff at New Hampshire Estates Elementary School:

- Believes that each child should be respected and valued as an individual with a unique background, pattern of growth, and rate of learning.
- Believes that it is our responsibility to help each child achieve academic and character building skills while nurturing curiosity, creativity, esthetic appreciation, and a social conscience.
- Believes no student has the right to stop a teacher from teaching or another student from learning.
- Believes that each child needs to be assisted in developing self-discipline, respect and responsibility, as well as motivation, to function as an effective member of society.

## **GOAL**

The staff at New Hampshire Estates Elementary will provide each student with a positive, success-oriented school environment with assistance from the school-wide behavior management plan. In order to ensure individual success, all professional and support staff will strive for consistency in addressing behavioral issues. All staff will use words of encouragement as well as the Key Messages: “This is important; I know you can do it; I won’t give up on you; effective effort leads to achievement.”
