The Federal Title 1 School Choice Option is offered in Title 1 Schools if the school does not meet specific standards on Maryland School Assessments (MSA). The MSA is an annual test in reading and mathematics. Although MSA results will not be released until this summer, we are holding a meeting at our school on Monday, May 9, 2011 at 7:00PM.
