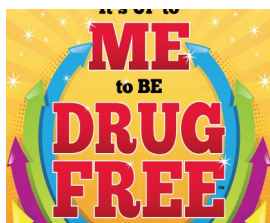
Seasonal Flu Clinic Friday, November 10th
