QUESTION ONE

What is a **passion** of yours? Why is it important to you? How did you develop this interest? How do you pursue it? What more might you do to develop your passion?

QUESTION TWO

What was a **project** of yours that was especially meaningful to you? What made it so? If you could continue this project, how would you improve or expand it?

QUESTION THREE

What is something you are **curious** about? What have you already learned, and what more would you like to learn? Where has this curiosity led you? Where do you think this curiosity may lead you in the future?

Ulysses Signature Program Guidelines**

To apply* to the Ulysses Signature Program, students must be:

1. Incoming ninth graders to NWHS
2. Recommended for the following three honors courses at the time of initial registration: English 9, US History, and Biology or Physics
3. Recommended by eighth grade English, history, and/or science teachers (forms required)
4. Reading on or above grade level
5. Writing on or above grade level
6. In good academic, attendance, and behavioral standing in middle school
7. Able to work independently in class
8. Able to work in cooperative groups in class
9. Able to complete homework, assignments, and projects in a satisfactory and timely manner
10. Interested in research, presentation, and completing independent and group projects, including the Senior Ulysses Project
11. Committed to a four-year program

*Application includes application form, teacher recommendation, and essay

To remain** in the Ulysses Signature Program, students must:

1. Maintain a grade point average of at least 2.75 in all Ulysses subject-area classes
2. Maintain exemplary attendance, punctuality, and behavioral records
3. Complete all coursework—including homework, reading, and projects—in a timely and satisfactory manner
4. Demonstrate academic integrity at all times, on all assignments
5. Apply lessons learned across the Ulysses subject areas: English, Social Studies, and Science
6. Take the initiative to seek assistance from teachers as needed
7. Be recommended by Ulysses teachers to continue to the next grade level of Ulysses classes

**Once a student leaves the Ulysses Signature Program, s/he will not be re-admitted.
