Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are so excited to welcome you and your family to the 4th grade CES program at Piney Branch Elementary! We are very eager to meet your child and anticipate a fabulous school year! As you are aware, students will be provided with textbooks, readers, visual aids, and most of the school supplies needed to demonstrate mastery. As a partner with the teacher and school, parents want to equip their child with important organizational tools and personal supplies to help them be successful in class.

It is suggested that students in 4th grade CES program bring the following individual organizational tools and personal supplies to school.

- 2 packs 3x5 index cards, lined
- 3 hardcover composition notebooks.
- 5 Pocket folders (red, green, blue, purple, yellow)
- Pencils (to be replenished as needed)
- Child safety scissors
- 1 box of colored pencils
- Eraser (pencil tops or large eraser)
- Personal pencil sharpener
- A pencil pouch (no pencil boxes please)
- 6 glue sticks
- 1 set personal headphones (that can be plugged into a computer)
- 1 box highlighters (variety of colors)
- 2 permanent markers
- 2 black ballpoint pens
- 3 packs sticky notes (1.5"x2")

If your family would like to donate any of the following items, they would be greatly appreciated - but are not required:

- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Clorox wipes
- Clear 2-Liter plastic bottles (for ecosystem project in Science)
- Ziploc Baggies
- 3x5 Index card box

Additionally, as a whole school initiative, our school has produced a student Agenda Book and Take-Home Folder available for student. They are used by teachers to help your child track his/her assignments and to let you know of assignments that are due. We strongly believe these materials are valuable organizational tools to help you and your child monitor tasks completion. Fees relating to field trips will be shared at the time of the trip.
