- Hand sanitizer
- Cleaning wipes
- Clear 2-Liter plastic bottles (for ecosystem project in Science)
- Ziploc Baggies
- Personal headphones (that can be plugged into a computer)

Additionally, as a whole school initiative, our school has produced a student Agenda Book and Take-Home Folder available for student. They are used by teachers to help your child track his/her assignments and to let you know of assignments that are due. We strongly believe these materials are valuable organizational tools to help you and your child monitor tasks completion. Fees relating to field trips will be shared at the time of the trip.
