



A College Level Experience for MCPS Students

The Early Access Program is a partnership between Montgomery County Public Schools and Montgomery College. It is designed to give high school seniors the opportunity to enroll in online, credit-bearing college courses at Montgomery College (MC). These courses will be taken during semester two in a computer lab at Quince Orchard High School during the regular school day. The course will be available online, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The student will be able to access and work on their online course at school and home, but one period will be scheduled into their seven period school day. Students are responsible for tuition, fees, and textbooks. Upon completion of each MC course, student grades will be recorded on an official MC transcript.
