

Off-Site Student Internships

Become actively involved in business, government, industry, research, or social service. An internship complements your school program and is pursued under the supervision of the school. Regularly scheduled in-school seminars explore career and work place issues. If you wish to learn about society directly and explore various career options, you will benefit from this program. Seventy-five hours of concurrent internship experience are required each semester for each .5 credit internship. Students must provide their own transportation.

Students intending to do an off-site internship must complete an application and return it to the internship coordinator. Interns are responsible for finding their own internship and can see the coordinator for details or ideas.
