

# MLA Style: How to cite print and electronic sources

## Print

Author, *Book (or Magazine) Title*, publication information, medium consulted (i.e., print).

### Books

#### One author:

Grisham, John. *Bleachers*. New York: Doubleday, 2003. Print.

#### Two authors:

Caldwell, Ian and Dustin Thomason. *The Rule of Four*. New York: Dial, 2004. Print.

#### Entry in an anthology:

Harwood, Richard. "Gun Control Laws Reduce Crime." *Crime and Criminals*. Ed Tamara Roleff. San Diego: Greenhaven Press, 2000. 64-67. Print.

#### Entry in a reference work:

"Hero." *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary*. 11<sup>th</sup> ed. 2003. Print.

Kettering, Alison. "Art Nouveau." *World Book Encyclopedia*. 2002 ed. Print.

#### Republished book:

Wells, H.G. *The Invisible Man*. 1897. New York: Bantam, 1983. Print.

## Electronic Sources

Author. Title in quotation marks. *Print publication title* and information. *Electronic publication information* (such as sponsor of the Web site). Medium consulted (i.e., Web). Date of access.
