
ORIENTATION SESSION FOR STUDENTS NEW TO REDLAND

On Thursday, August 25, 2011, there will be an orientation for all of our incoming sixth graders, as well as seventh and eighth grade students who are **NEW TO REDLAND**. New students must be registered with the Counseling Office to attend Redland prior to attending orientation.

The start time is 7:55 a.m. Montgomery County Public School buses will provide transportation following the bus routes enclosed in this summer packet. All students attending orientation should report to their designated bus stops at least 10 minutes before the scheduled pick-up time. Students will be dismissed at 11:40 a.m. Buses will return students to their bus stop.

All students new to Redland are invited and encouraged to attend this half-day orientation session. During this orientation session, all students new to Redland will have an opportunity to walk through their schedules, meet their teachers, and become familiar with Redland Middle School.
