

What is Reading Initiative?

Reading Initiative is how we make our class sizes smaller for Language Arts. In school, we often refer to it as Book Club. Mrs. Deutsch, our Reading Initiative teacher, takes approximately 3-4 children from each of the four first grades and has them for a three-hour block in the morning. This allows us all to provide the small group instruction that fosters reading and writing success. Her class is not remedial, nor is it enrichment. She has a range of students, as do the rest of the classes. Formal reading testing is completed three times a year, and it is possible that the classes for Language Arts may change to create a narrower range of reading abilities in each classroom.
