Summer Reading for 2011/2012 French IV IB Students

- 1) Students are to read entirely *Le Petit Prince* by Antoine de Saint Exupéry in French. (there are online versions available or you may pick up a book from the IB Office **starting June 30, 2011**)
- 2) Students will be expected to be able to translate into English the entire vocabulary contained in the book (nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and locutions). Therefore, it is recommended to read the book with the help of a bilingual dictionary.
- 3) Students may buy *A la Découverte du Petit Prince* a corresponding workbook, or check out a workbook and write the answers on their own notebook. Workbooks available **June 30, 2011** from the IB Office)
- 4) Students must answer in French, and in complete sentences, **only** the following questions in their workbook:
