From the Health Room

We have had several cases of head lice recently. We ask that our families are diligent about taking the necessary steps to minimize the transmission of lice (e.g. talking to children about not sharing outerwear, reporting cases to the health room, and thoroughly treating head lice if it is present). If your child is sent home due to head lice, you will need to accompany him/her upon their return to school for a post-treatment inspection in the health room. If you have questions about head lice, an informative letter regarding the identification, treatment, and prevention of head lice was distributed in September.
