Interim Reports

Teachers distributed interim reports today. First and second grade students receive an interim if they are at risk of receiving an "N" in any subject. Third through fifth grade students receive an interim if they are at risk of receiving a "C" or lower in any subject. Kindergarteners do not receive interims. The purpose of the interims is to inform parents of student performance. If your child receives an interim, I strongly recommend that you contact your child's teacher.

Data Notebooks

Students will take home their data notebooks on October 15th. Every Rock View student maintains a data notebook. They use the notebooks to record their performance data, monitor their progress, and set goals for themselves. The notebooks are also a good communication tool. We send them home on the 15th of every month, starting in October. Please review the data notebook with your child and then send it back to school the next day. As always, contact your child's teacher with any questions.

Fall Festival

We will have our annual Fall Festival Parade and classroom parties at 1:30 p.m. on Friday, October 30th. We will be sending home additional information regarding the parade routes and plans for the parties. Students may wear their costumes in the parade. Please remember that fake weapons, even if it is a part of a costume, are not allowed in school. If you do not want your child to participate in the Fall Festival activities, please contact your classroom teacher as soon as possible.



Star Jar

You may have heard your child talk about the "Star Jar." The Star Jar is a school-wide incentive program. Students have opportunities to earn "stars" throughout the school day. Every other Friday, we have a "Star Jar" party where one student from each class is picked at random out of their jar. Students with more stars have a greater chance of being chosen, so encourage your child to earn stars in class! The selected students receive a small treat and a certificate. Often times, the treat is an activity, such as participating in a game of silent speedball. It is a great motivator for the students.
