Language Arts

The student will:

1. Work on letter recognition
 - a. associating letters with their sounds
 - b. correct formation of letters
2. Write first name on lined paper
3. Listen to multi-step directions and be able to follow them
4. Listen to stories and answer questions about them
5. Continue Writer's Workshop and journal writing
6. Begin unit on folktales and fairy tales



Math

The student will:

1. Read, write, and count up to 31
2. Make comparisons of sets (equal or unequal and more or less)
3. Use ordinal numbers (first, second, third, fourth, fifth)
4. Count by 10s and 5s to 100 and 2s to 20



Social Studies

The student will:

1. Become familiar with Native Americans and Pilgrims, and their customs.
2. Compare and contrast families living today and in the past
3. Become familiar with different winter traditions (Hanukkah, Christmas, and Kwanzaa)



4. Learn about Martin Luther King, Jr.

The student will:

1. Learn about the five senses
2. Discuss seasonal changes
3. Continue All About Me unit
