Quarter 3

Language Arts

The student will:

1. Continue working on letter recognition
 - a. associating letters with their sounds
 - b. correct formation of letters
2. Begin writing first and last name on lined paper
3. Identify main characters, setting, and problems
4. Continue to work on reading skills
5. Continue Writer's Workshop and journal writing
6. Read books by Jan Brett, Dr. Seuss, and Laura Numeroff
7. Identify and create words that rhyme



Math

The student will:

1. Continue to practice counting, writing, and identifying numbers to 31 and beyond.
2. Measure length and capacity using nonstandard units
3. Identify and describe 2D and 3D shapes
4. Tell time to the hour on an analog clock
5. Identify times of the day
6. Celebrate the 100th day of school



Social Studies

The student will:

1. Become familiar with George Washington and Abraham Lincoln



2. Become familiar with special days (Groundhog Day, Chinese New Year, Valentine's Day, President's Day, and St. Patrick's Day)

Science

The student will:

1. Discuss seasonal changes
2. Learn how to take care of your teeth
3. Explore balls and ramps



Personal and Social Growth

The student will:

1. Continue to put on and button or zip his/her jacket
2. Continue to follow class rules
3. Continue to pay attention
4. Continue to follow directions
5. Continue to be responsible for taking care of his/her belongings and for getting things to and from school (ex. Folder, book bag, homework, library book, etc.)
6. Continue to cooperate with other children
7. Use courteous language and manners



Rigor (first grade challenges)

The student will:

1. Identify first grade sight words
2. Read books at their appropriate letter
3. Measure weight, length, time and capacity using standard units
4. Read names of shapes and plot them on a grid
