6:40- Budget

Prepare budget for General PTA Budget Vote Oct. 5. The vote will be followed by presentations from the middle school magnet programs.

- Cultural Performances: Some events had been cancelled leaving a surplus on that line item. But assemblies are expensive. "Two science assemblies cost \$1,000." Nilam said. So the budget was raised to \$1300.
- Field Trips: A one-time adjustment will be made to field trips but it must be officially documented. It includes \$400 for Pre-K and Headstart.
- After School Programs: Daniel discussed after-school program scholarships. There should be a limit of two scholarships per year per student. All the coordinators will have access to a googel.doc to document scholarships. HOS gets scholarships from the Judy Center. Nilam added the following programs this fall. Lego Robots, Spanish/ French and Yoga. Continuing after school classes are Teatro de Luna, Creative Adventures and HOS. A room is needed for yoga. A co-coordinator should be in the front office the day after the forms are handed out to collect the forms.
- Tiger Tales: Teacher Sara Chung is the Writing Support Specialist and will be in charge of Tiger Tales this year. She will get each student to write for the magazine. So it is not a PTA committee now.
- Teacher Support: This should be given to Nancy Legam this year, a special Ed. Teacher. The support is for a teacher who acts as team leader.
- NAACP parents' council: Needs \$100 per meeting for food. They will raise money.

- Walk to School: Kerry Hufford says they need more cereal bars and water. \$200 added.
- Membership: Meredith tells us that we've received \$2300 in the form of more than 80 memberships. The membership form is available on the school website and on the PTA bulletin board. We have one teacher member.
