Pathway: Early Child Development (*CTE Program)

A: Required Courses:

Child & Adolescent Development 1A/1B
Child & Adolescent Development 2A/2B
Child & Adolescent Development 3A/3B

B: Capstone: Choose one of the following:

Child & Adolescent Development Internship (List twice for double period)
Psychology, Advanced Placement A/B

Pathway: Print and/or Broadcast Media

A: Required Courses—must complete at least three credits from the following:

TV Production A/B*
Radio Production 1 A/B
Electronic Audio Field Production (Radio Production 2) A/B
Radio Station Management & Operations (Radio Production 3) A/B
Yearbook A/B*
Journalism A/B (prerequisite to Newspaper)
Newspaper A/B*

*Denotes repeatable course

B: Capstone experience

Examples of career choices:

Pathway: Visual/Performing Arts

A: One of the following required courses:

Chorus 1, Chorus 2 (entry level for 10th – 12th), Concert Band A/B, Symphonic Band A/B, Symphonic Orchestra A/B, Piano 1 A/B, Guitar A/B
Art & Culture, Ceramics/Sculpture 1 A/B, Foundations of Art A/B, Photography 1 A/B, Studio Art 1 A/B, Digital Art A/B
Theater 1A and/or 2B

B: Required elective courses (two credits or more):

Chorus Honors 3A/B or Show Choir A/B, Chamber Singers A/B, Symphonic Band Honors A/B, Piano 2 A/B, Lab Jazz A/B, Music Perspectives A/B, AP Music Theory, Music Technology
Ceramics/Sculpture 2 & 3 A/B, Advanced Digital Art A/B, Photography 2 & 3 A/B, Studio Art 2 & 3 A/B
Advanced Acting A/B, Stage Design A/B, Play Directing A/B, Dance
AP Art History
Fashion Design

Pathway: Global Studies

A: Required Courses:

Global Issues of the 20th Century (.5)
One additional credit of a Foreign Language (beyond the credits already required)

B: One of the following courses:

International Economics
AP Economics (Micro or Macro)
AP Comparative Government and Politics

Required Elective Courses—choose two or more (see course bulletin for complete list):

AP European History A/B, AP World History A/B, Comparative Religions, International & Domestic Law, History of East Asia, African-American Experience, History of Latin America, Creative Writing, Philosophy, Art & Culture A/B, AP Art History A/B, International Business, International Cultures & Cuisines, Dance as Fine Art, International Sports, World Literature, Journalism A/B
