- Binder (3-ringed)
- Composition notebooks (marble-colored)
- Crayons
- Markers
- Pencils - No.2 (non-mechanical)

Grade 5

- Binder (3-ring)
- Composition notebooks (marbled-colored)
- Notebook paper (wide-ruled)
- Pocket folders
- Cap erasers
- Pencil pouch (3-hole)
- Pencils - No.2 (non-mechanical)
