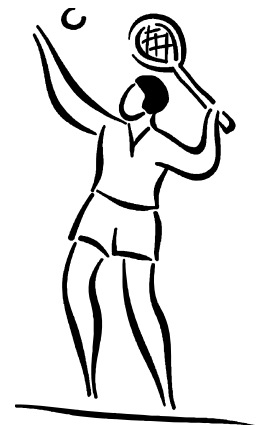
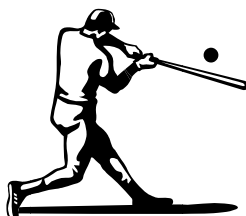

After School Activities

Active Wolves – is a new club that provides a safe, competitive, athletic environment for students. Participants will develop flexibility, strength, and endurance, while focusing on self-esteem, respect, and teamwork skills. Join the fun and play in a variety of sporting events. Active Wolves meet every Thursday in the Gym, after school.

Bridge Club – is sponsored by Mrs. Nakassis and is taught by a Master Player, Dr. Ron Starr. No experience is necessary. Students will be taught the basic rules of bidding and playing Duplicate Bridge. During the year, tournaments will be held and a trophy will be given out at the end of the year. Refreshments are provided.

Environmental (KEEP) Club – is for students who want to help keep the school grounds nice by planting plants and flowers, maintaining the courtyard, recycling, and other projects that maintain a friendly and safe environment.

Homework Club – will serve all interested students who want or require assistance with homework or other school-related projects/activities or assignments.
