What's Going on in Second Grade?

Reading: Currently, we are studying text features in nonfiction texts and how they help us understand the text. We will also continue working on identifying the main idea in non-fiction text.

Math: We will continue our unit on geometry. Students will identify plane and solid shapes and name their attributes.

Writing: In the second quarter, we will begin writing to inform. Students will use informational texts to research on different topics. Students will then organize the information and write their own informational piece on that topic.

Social Studies: November is American Indian Heritage month. Second graders will be learning all about the life of the Wampanoag Indian tribe.
