Principally Speaking: A Message from Mrs. Sirgo

The Montgomery County Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) will conduct a free flu vaccine clinic on **November 10 2011, for students enrolled at Woodlin Elementary School from 1:00-3:00 pm.** This is a half day for students and occurs after dismissal.

Only nasal spray flu vaccine (FluMist) will be available. Students will not be vaccinated unless they are accompanied by a parent, guardian, or adult designated by the parent and bring the completed and signed **Consent Form.** Notification letters, consent forms, and Vaccine Information Statements will be provided to students in early October. Other FluMist clinics for all school-aged children will be conducted on October 31, 2011, at Albert Einstein High School in Kensington and between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. To make an appointment for the October 31 clinics go to <http://www.montgomerycountymd.gov/flu> or call 311.

The injectable seasonal flu vaccine will be available, at no charge, at other DHHS flu clinics at various locations in the county, October through December. 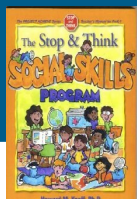
