Dear Parents:

We look forward to seeing all of you during our November conferences. We are well on our way to 2010. Some activities that your child will be involved in these two months are listed below.

Reading:

We will continue our Reading Initiative program. We are reading stories and books aloud and silently. Children continue to make progress in reading. To help your child with comprehension, it is important for you to ask questions related to the stories. Some examples of questions would be:

- What is the main idea of the story?
- How do you know that?
- What was the problem in the story?
- How was the problem resolved?

Spelling

We are continuing our spelling program by exploring word wall words and chunks. Do not forget to look for your child's spelling list in their folders on every other Monday. Tests are given every other week. We have posted the spelling lists on our school webpage. You will find them at

Writing:

We are practicing our handwriting skills. Journal writing remains an important part of our program on a

weekly basis. We are continuing to work on writing sentences using correct punctuation and capitalization. For the 2nd quarter, we will be working on writing to inform.

Math:

In Math, we will be working on calendar skills, money, place value, measurement, and time. Please be sure to work on addition and subtraction facts with your child using the flashcards that were sent home. Be sure you are keeping up with the math logs for basic facts.
