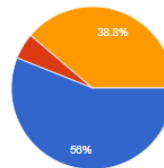
Coordinator Clements's Comments

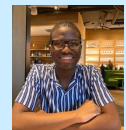


of YAG members which should be attributed to Mr. Bassett's passion for educating students about the political process

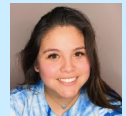

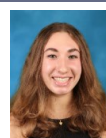
