1) Product Variations – Summary

a) Product Variation Basics

Product Variations is a way to merge multiple **OSP Products** into 1 unified OSP Product in the **school store**. This is useful for items like clothing, chaperone vs student tickets, split payments etc.


b) Create Your OSP Product Variations

To make an OSP Product Variation, first you will need to create your individual OSP Products.

Go to the **Transactions tab** \rightarrow **OSP Products page.**



This will take you to the **OSP Product setup page**.




Now, you'll need to either edit or create your specific **Product Variations**. Go to either **Edit** or the **Add New button.**

Please note: Any previously made Activities will automatically be copied into the new OSP Products type. You **DO NOT** to recreate any previously made Activities or Summary Obligations.



Fill out the **OSP Product fields** as needed and then select the **Save button**.




You'll need to make 1 OSP Product for each unique Product Variation.

So, for example, if you are doing t-shirt sizes for small to large, you'll need to make 3x separate OSP Products.

- 1. School T-Shirt Size Small
- 2. School T-Shirt Size Medium
- 3. School T-Shirt Size Large

It should look like this:



Use of the **Copy Button** is encouraged as it will speed up this process.




c) Create Your Base Product

After you make your Product Variations, you will need to **make one additional OSP Product as your Base Product**.


To do this, go back into **OSP Products** and make a **Base Product**. This can be **copy** of a previous Product Variation. (The **Base Product** is not actually for sale so this is just dummy info. Fields like **price** do not matter).

It is recommended that you include **phrases like "all sizes" or "all options**" to indicate that your item has more than 1 variation.



So, in our earlier example, should now look something like this:

- 1. School T-Shirt Size Small
- 2. School T-Shirt Size Medium
- 3. School T-Shirt Size Large
- 4. School T-Shirt All Sizes




d) Merge Your Product Variations

At this point, you can now merge your items.

Go into the **Transactions tab** →**OSP Product Variations Page**.




Find your Base Product and select the corresponding Edit button.



This will open up the OSP Product Variations page for your Base Product.

You will need to do 5 things on this page:




First, you'll need to create a **List name**.


It is recommended that you include phrases like "all sizes" or "all options" to indicate that your item has more than one variation.




Next you will go to **Available Variations**. Select your first **OSP Product** so it turns gray. Then you will click on the **Right Arrow button** to merge.



The **OSP Product** should now display in the **Selected Variations box**. Be sure to also type in a **Label** for this item.




Continue merging and labeling your other Product Variations.



Be sure to insert them in the order you want – this will be indicated by the Sort # column.



Once your items are inserted in the **correct order** and **labelled**, you can select the **Save button**.



e) Product Variations in the School Store

If your **OSP Products** are **active** (available for purchase), your **OSP Product Variations** should now visible. You'll notice that the **Base Product** will display on the main page under your **School Name** in the **School Store**.



The **Product Variations** will display on the **Store Product Page** in the **drop down**.
