Resolution No. 662-83 Re: Larchmont Elementary School

On motion of Mrs. Shannon seconded by Dr. Shoenberg, the following resolution was adopted with Mr. Ewing, Mrs. Praisner, Mrs. Shannon, and Dr. Shoenberg voting in the affirmative; Mrs. Peyser voting in the negative; Dr. Greenblatt abstaining:

Resolved, That the following be conveyed to the County Council:

1. The Board of Education encourages the Council to explore the possibility of providing the necessary funds to reimburse Grace Episcopal Church for expended funds at the former Larchmont Elementary School site so that the Grace Episcopal School can move from that site.
2. The Board would then encourage the county to find another appropriate user for the Larchmont school building and pledges its support and assistance in that effort.
3. Should this effort fail, the Board of Education would encourage discussion which would assure minimal impact on the Rosemary Hills, Chevy Chase, and North Chevy Chase integration effort.
