

Do you know anyone living in any of the following situations?



Living in Shelters/ **Transitional Housing**

This includes domestic violence shelters, homeless shelters, youth shelters, trailers provided by Federal Emergency Management Agency, housing paid for by programs such as Rapid Re-Housing, transitional living facilities, etc.



Living in Hotels/Motels

Staying in motels/hotels due to lack of adequate alternatives.



Staying with others

Staying with others due to loss of housing, economic hardship, or a similar reason is included.



Unsheltered

This includes staying in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.
