Literacy SMARTIE Goals

School Literacy Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, [at least 81.9%](#) of all students will meet the academic milestone for proficiency in literacy.

Gap Reduction Goal (This represents the **individual projected growth** for students. Achieving this goal will close gaps between student groups; it reduces predictability in outcomes and supports the achievement of both the school and district goals; accomplishing this is essential to close gaps in student experience and achievement, which will therefore support the school in accomplishing both the school and district goals):

By the middle of 2023-2024 **at least** 18% (currently 12%) of Special Education students will meet or **exceed** individual projected growth goals on the MAP RIT score (fall to winter).

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, **at least** 66% of all EML students will show growth in making progress towards learning English on MCAP WIDA ACCESS for ELLs. (from 61%-66%).

Math SMARTIE Goals

School Math Goal (This represents the overall **student achievement** of an underserved focus group(s). Achieving this goal will be essential in order to accomplish the District goal for all students, and address the root cause of inequity at the school level):

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, [at least 81.4%](#) of all students will meet the academic milestone for proficiency in math.

Gap Reduction Goal (This represents the **individual projected growth** for students. Achieving this goal will close gaps between student groups; it reduces predictability in outcomes and supports the achievement of both the school and district goals; accomplishing this is essential to close gaps in student experience and achievement, which will therefore support the school in accomplishing both the school and district goals):

By the end of 2023-2024 at least 50% of Kindergarten Hispanic students will meet the academic milestone for mathematics on their **Evidence of Learning EOY External (MAP) measure** (from 44% to 50%).

By the end of 2023-2024 **at least** 55% of Grade 1-5 African American and Hispanic students will meet the academic milestone for mathematics on their Evidence of Learning **EOY District (Eureka) measure** (from 20%-25%)

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Culture/Climate SMARTIE Goals

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, we will increase reports by Hispanic students feeling a deep sense of belonging.

Well-Being SMARTIE Goals

By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, decrease chronic absenteeism by 10-12% over three years for Hispanic Kindergarten and first grade students.
