#### Welcome Back, Students and Staff!

Parent/Guardians of 6th grade students — If you dropped off medications for your 6th grader for Outdoor Ed, please come to the Health Room and pick up the remaining medication. Medications can not be sent home with students.

Registration for the 2024-2025 school year is coming up. **Baker Parent Articulation Night for rising 6th, 7th, and 8th graders** *(current 5th, 6th, and 7th graders)* will be held on Thursday, **January 18, 2024**. Baker counselors will be in 6th and 7th grade Social Studies classes January 17-19, 2024, to talk about course options for the upcoming school year. Registration for 6th and 7th grade students will take place January 22-26, 2024. Registration will be done at home using a Google form.

Damascus High School Parent Orientation for parents of rising 9th graders (*current 8th graders*) will be held on Wednesday, January 17, 2024, at the high school. DHS counselors will be at Baker to discuss course options with 8th graders during a Town Hall on January 18, 2024. Online registration will be held in English classes on January 23, 2024.

Please be sure to ask your children if they are missing any assignments or assessments. You may check the ParentVue, or your child's planner, for updates.





#### 2023-2024 MCPS Inclement Weather and Operating Status

This is the full list of systemwide weather-related and operating status options for Montgomery County Public Schools and provides guidelines related to school status and activities during certain emergency conditions, and identifies the various levels of personnel.



- ICB Childcare Programs follow the responses for MCPS administrative offices
- CUPF Community Use Activities are canceled when schools are closed, for the morning if there is a 2 hour delay, and for the afternoon when schools are dismissed early
- Emergency personnel must report to work and perform work for all status options, as in the negotiated contracts
