





- The Course Duration column displays the duration for a course in the Selected Course Requests and Selected Alternate Course Requests sections

- . The arrow on the far left of the course ID provides additional information regarding the course

Consider a Pathway: group of courses with an area of concentration


The IB program and courses start in 11th Grade. Some AP options are available in 9th.




