





Prepping for Prom Timeline

A few months before prom (February-March)

- Shop for your prom outfit
- Book makeup, hairstylist, and nail artist appointments
- Determine a place to take pre-prom photos
- Book your transportation (ex. limo)
- Make dinner reservations
- Pay all financial obligations and senior dues (see above*)

A month before prom (March)

- Plan your pre-prom activities
- Plan your post-prom activities
- Make sure your prom outfit fits you perfectly
- Practice wearing your heels to have a pain-free prom night
- Plan your accessories and jewelry
- Buy your prom tickets (see above*)
- Have your parent or guardian email to notify the school of an early dismissal for Friday, April 17th (see above*)
- Submit your guest form (see above*)

Two weeks before prom (Early April)

- Confirm all your reservations and appointments
- Do a trial outfit, makeup, and hairstyle run
- Order a corsage or boutonniere
- Shop for all necessities. This includes random things you might need (socks, heel pads, stain removers, etc...)

If you haven't already,

- buy prom tickets (see above*)
- complete guest forms (see above*)
- have your parents/guardians send an e-mail to Ms. Norfolk for early dismissal on Friday, April 17th (see above*)

On the day of prom (Friday, April 17th)

- Head to your appointments
- Pack your purse or bag
- Get your overnight bag ready for post-prom sleepovers




Parking Information

- Student parking on campus is by permit only and is located in the lot by the stadium and the row of spaces between the school and the stadium.
- Only SENIORS and JUNIORS are eligible for a parking permit
- Permits are valid for one semester only and are limited in number.
- Pay \$39 online with your parking application
- Parking is a privilege that may be revoked for disciplinary reasons.

It's a Team Effort!

When you hear or see something that isn't right, SAY SOMETHING:

Students often speak amongst themselves- unaware that others may be listening. Report immediately any conversation about unsafe behavior to school staff.

Do NOT prop doors open. Do NOT open doors for anyone: The number one way for us to keep our building safe is to ensure that all of our exterior doors are locked and that everyone who enters the building properly checks in at the main office.

DO NOT go to other school properties during the school day; DO NOT facilitate non-RHS students being on our campus. Trespassers will be charged and face suspension; cars will be towed.

Treat every drill and alarm as if it is a true emergency:

Our brains are wired to repeat actions we've practiced. In a real emergency, we count on this to help us stay safe.

Remain Silent during emergencies and drills. Situations can change quickly. Everyone needs to remain vigilant and ready to act.






