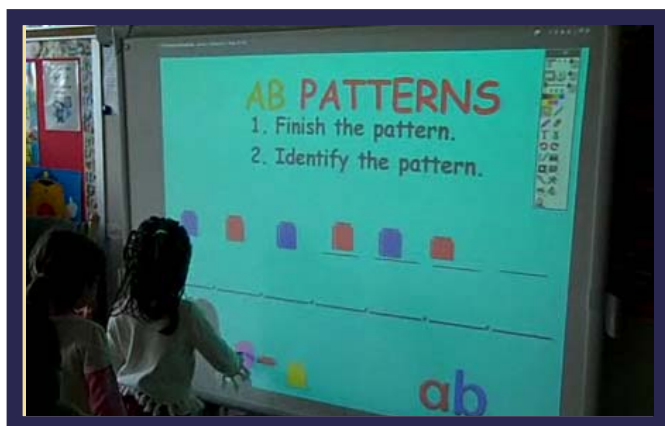




The new NaturalReader software is available in every school and will read any text on the screen
