Zip Files: Emailing Large or Multiple Files

If you have a file that is too large for email, or if you would like to email the contents of a folder without having to attach each individual file, then you can compress or "zip" the files into a single file.




What is a zip file?



A zip file is a compressed file with the extension .zip. It can contain one or many files. The files must be "extracted" or "unzipped" before they can be used.

How do I create a zip file?

- 1. Select the file or files that you want to "zip"
- 2. Right click on one of the selected files
- 3. Choose Send to → Compressed Zip folder



4. The zipfile will be automatically created in the same location and will be named the same name as whichever file your pointer was on when you right-clicked. You can rename that file whatever you like.



Now you can copy that file to a flash drive or email it to someone.

How do I use a file contained in a zip file?

- 1. If you have received an email with a zip file attached, download the attachment to your computer. Make sure you choose SAVE instead of OPEN when you are downloading the file
- 2. Navigate to where you saved the file
- 3. Right click on the file
- 4. Choose Extract All
- 5. Click **Next** through the wizard and finally **Finish**
- 6. A folder will open with all of the files that were contained in the zip file
- 7. You can now delete the zip file from your computer
