Executive Summary

The Surveys of School Environment (SSE) are designed to improve students' academic success by providing information about how parents, students, and staff perceive their school environment. Survey results are used to monitor progress toward goals in the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*. Respondents were asked to consider their own school's environment in providing responses.

Overall, responding groups perceived their school environments positively. Perceptions of the school environment were fairly high for all three school levels. Elementary school parents' mean positive perceptions range from a low of 88.1% for Physical Environment to a high of 94.6% for Social Environment. Elementary students' positive perceptions range from a low of 66.2% for Physical Environment to a high of 83.9% for Social Environment. Elementary staff mean positive perceptions range from a low of 72.6% for Physical Environment to a high of 85.0% for Job Satisfaction.

MCPS middle school parents' positive perceptions range from a low of 75.0% for Partnerships to a high of 90.6% for Social Environment. Middle school students' mean positive perceptions range from a low of 59.5% for Physical Environment to a high of 74.7% for Partnerships. Middle school staff mean positive perceptions range from a low of 70.3% for School Safety and Discipline to a high of 80.7% for Staff Training. High school parents report positive perception ranges from a low of 70.8% for Partnerships to a high of 89.1% for Parent Satisfaction. The mean positive perceptions for high school students range from a low of 59.8% for Physical Environment to a high of 74.1% for Partnerships. The mean positive perceptions for high school staff range from a low of 64.8% for Physical Environment to a high of 86.1% for Job Satisfaction.

The response rates for parents continue to be low, with only a small increase in 2004–2005 elementary school parent responses from the 2003–2004 school year. The elementary school response rate of parents in 2004–2005 was 23.2%. Response rates for middle and high school parents in 2004–2005 were 14.3% and 11.4%, respectively. Student response rates continue to be high with an increase in 2004–2005 for middle and high school students. Elementary students' response rate is strong at 87.4%, while middle school students' response rate increased to 87.2%, and high school students' response rate increased to 75.8%. Staff response rates showed improvement only in high school. The 2004–2005 staff response rate for elementary schools was 44.0%, while middle and high schools had response rates of 37.4% and 33.6%, respectively. Overall, the elementary school level continues to have the highest response rates for parents, students, and staff.

The Department of Shared Accountability (DSA) convened a work group during spring 2005, in an effort to increase response rates and better serve school needs. DSA proposed shortening the survey for the 2005–2006 administration. In addition, Candlewood Elementary School and Hoover Middle School volunteered to pilot a computer-based version of the survey for their students. The Web-based pilot student survey administration received a positive response from students and staff. DSA has proposed giving all elementary and middle schools the option to use the online version rather than the paper and pencil version of the survey.

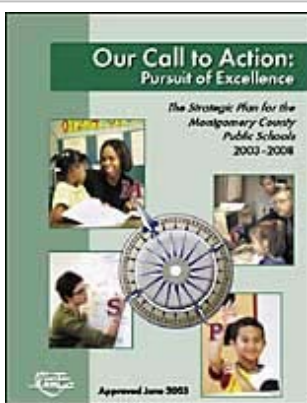
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Districtwide Summary of the 2004–2005 Surveys of School Environment

Background

The Surveys of School Environment (SSE) are designed to provide information about the school environment. SSEs were first administered during the 2001–2002 school year. Survey results are used to monitor progress toward goals in the Montgomery County Public Schools (MCPS) strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence* (2005). In 2004–2005, the survey items were divided into nine broad general areas: Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, Administrative Environment, Social Environment, School Safety and Discipline, Physical Environment, Partnerships, Satisfaction, and Training.

Effect of School Environment

Research has shown that the school environment affects students' learning and feelings of social confidence. One essential classroom requirement is a learning environment free from distractions such as disruptions from other students (National Association of Secondary School Principals, 2002). The connection between students and teachers also plays a key role in the student's well-being. An April 2002 study of adolescents by the National Longitudinal Study of Adolescent Health showed that "connectedness" is essential for a student's healthy academic career. Schools with caring teachers have fewer students engaging in drugs and violence (Bowman, 2002).

For effective learning, it is critical that students feel comfortable in their school and classroom environment. In a study concerning "safe space," university students were surveyed about their feelings of safety to express their thoughts and ideas in the classroom. The results identify that the instructor had a crucial role in fostering an environment in which students could risk expressing themselves. These students felt most academically challenged within this "safe space" environment and felt comfortable asking for help when needed. The students in this study were more likely to complete their readings and show interest in their "safe" classes (Holley & Steiner, 2005). In a study of sixth graders, students would only ask for help from teachers with whom they felt comfortable. Most important, the students' confidence in their academic work was determined by their teachers' confidence. Encouragement from the teacher would allow a student to trust himself or herself

and become more expressive in class. Students with low expectations from their teachers are less inclined to excel beyond expectations (Raider-Roth, 2005).

Student relationships with peers are essential to an optimal learning environment. Students are able to express their ideas and ask questions when they feel safe from criticism. When students felt free to speak and listen to other students, they were able to learn from each other and were more interested in the content of their instruction (Holley & Steiner, 2005). In many American schools, students are afraid of being labeled or teased when participating in their classes. This learning environment prevents academic growth for many students. Schools and teachers need to create a learning environment in which academic achievement is prized among peers (Blair, 2003).

Methodology

This section of the report will identify the research questions that will be addressed in the results section and review the sampling, administration, and reporting procedures.

1. How many parents, students, and staff completed surveys during 2004–2005? How has participation changed over time?
2. What do the parent, student, and staff survey results tell us about the school environment in MCPS by school level?
3. How have perceptions changed over time?
4. How are survey results used for the MCPS strategic plan, *Our Call to Action: Pursuit of Excellence*?

Sampling Frame

Parents and students from every school were included in the sample. The sampling frame included all students in Grades 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, and 11; parents of students in those grades; Grade 2 for K–2 schools; and, beginning in 2002–2003, parents of students in Grade 1. All school-based staff members were surveyed.

Administration of the Surveys

The Surveys of School Environment (SSE) are distributed between February and April of each school year. Student surveys are administered in school during a window of six weeks. This allows school administrators and teachers some flexibility in the timing of the student survey administration so as not to interfere with the MCPS testing calendar.

Parent surveys are sent home with elementary students and mailed to parents of middle and high school students. All parents are asked to return the surveys to DSA in pre-addressed, postage-paid envelopes.

Since 2002–2003, school-based staff members have received their surveys at their work locations. School-based staff surveys may be returned through the MCPS Pony delivery system or by mail through the U. S. Postal Service with postage paid by MCPS.

Reporting of School and District Data

The method used to report each school’s survey results was determined by the response rate. A statistical analysis was conducted to determine if the responding sample was statistically representative of the school. Specific decision rules are reported in Appendix A. Data were examined for representation and, if necessary, adjusted by using a weighting process to ensure proper representation so that results could be generalized. Parent and staff data were found not to

be representative and were adjusted by weighting; both raw response and adjusted data are provided in all tables.

School-level results were calculated by first computing the percentage of individual respondents who responded either “Agree” or “Strongly Agree” on an item. The item percentages were averaged to Specific Areas; Specific Areas were then averaged to calculate the mean positive perception for a Broad Area. Districtwide results were calculated by aggregating respondents from elementary, middle, and high schools. Parent and student results for each school are available in the appendixes. Staff data are only available at the districtwide level.

Results

This section reports results for parents, students, and staff and is organized to respond to the questions identified in the methodology.

Parent, Student, and Staff Respondents

The response rates for the parent surveys continue to be low, with a small increase in elementary responses from last year (2003–2004). Student response rates for middle and high schools have increased. Staff response rates showed increases only in high school. Elementary school continues to have the highest response rates from parents, students, and staff (Table 1).

Parent, Student, and Staff Perceptions

Overall, responding groups perceived their school environments positively. Perceptions of the school environment for all three school levels were fairly high; a majority of Broad Areas were viewed positively by at least 75% of the parent respondents at all levels and by student and staff respondents in elementary schools.

Elementary Schools

Parents report high rates of satisfaction with their children's elementary schools. The Physical Environment was the lowest perceived Broad Area for parents, students, and staff. The 2004–2005 parent mean positive perceptions range from a low of 88.1% for Physical Environment to a high of 94.6% for Social Environment (Table 2).

Elementary students have a positive perception of their schools. Their 2004–2005 mean positive perceptions range from a low of 66.2% for Physical Environment to a high of 83.9% for Social Environment. Elementary staff mean positive perceptions range from a low of 72.6% for Physical Environment to a high of 85.0% for Job Satisfaction. As seen in Table 2, results were generally consistent over time. There have been no statistically significant changes from last year in any elementary parent or student Broad Areas.

Middle Schools

Middle school parents reported positive perceptions for all Broad Areas. Parent mean positive perceptions in 2004–2005 ranged from a low of 75.0% for Partnerships to a high of 90.6% for Social Environment (Table 3).

Middle school students' mean positive perceptions in 2004–2005 range from a low of 59.5% for Physical Environment to a high of 74.7% for Partnerships. Middle school staff mean positive perceptions range from a low of 70.3% for School Safety and Discipline to a high of 80.7% for Staff Training. Middle school parents had three Broad Areas that saw a significant increase from last year in addition to showing a 3-year trend of increases—Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, and Satisfaction. Similar to elementary schools, middle school staff Job Satisfaction had a statistically significant decrease from last year, and has shown a 3-year declining trend.

High Schools

Similar patterns occur at the high school level. High school parents report positive perceptions for all Broad Areas. Mean positive perception in 2004–2005 ranged from a low of 70.8% for Partnerships to a high of 89.1% for Parent Satisfaction (Table 4).

High school students have the same pattern as middle school students. The mean positive perceptions in 2004–2005 ranged from a low of 59.8% for Physical Environment to a high of 74.1% for Partnerships. High school staff perceptions have the same pattern as elementary school staff. The mean positive perceptions ranged from a low of 64.8% for Physical Environment to a high of 86.1% for Job Satisfaction. With the exception of Partnerships, all high school Broad Areas for parents and students showed a statistically significant increase from last year. High school parents had four Broad Areas that had a significant increase from last year and showed a 3-year trend. These are Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, Social Environment, and Satisfaction. For students, Academic Environment, Social Environment, and Satisfaction all had a statistically significant increase from last year, and a 3-year increasing trend.

Survey Results in the MCPS Strategic Plan

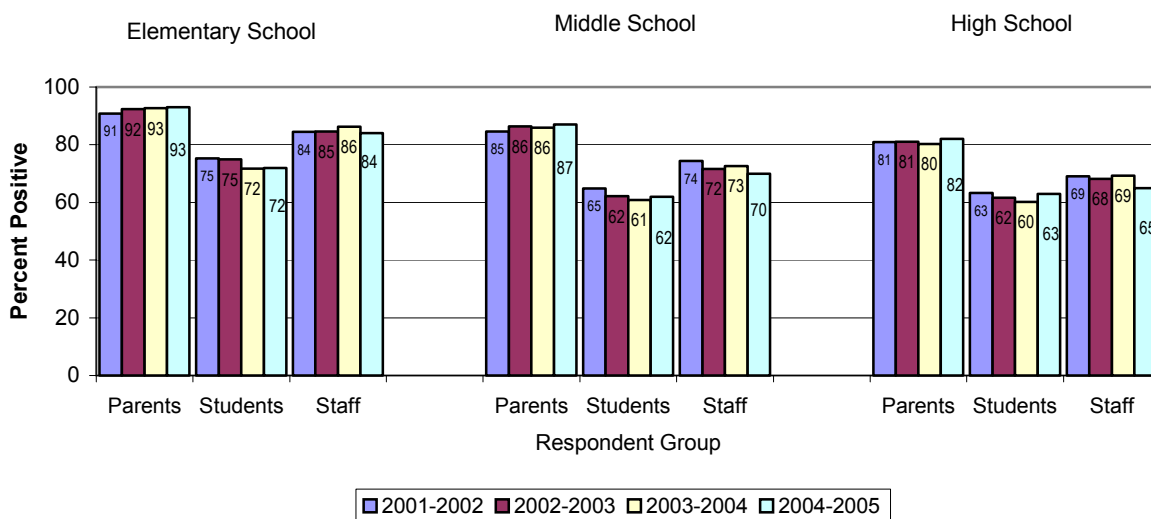


Figure 1. Parent, student, and school-based staff by school-level positive perceptions of School Safety and Discipline.

Results from the Surveys of School Environment (SSE) for the Broad Area School Safety and Discipline were used to monitor *Goal 1: Ensure Success for Every Student*. Data relevant to the milestone, “All students will be educated in learning environments that are safe, drug-free, and conducive to learning,” is presented in Figure 1. The data points show that the positive perceptions are all above 60%.

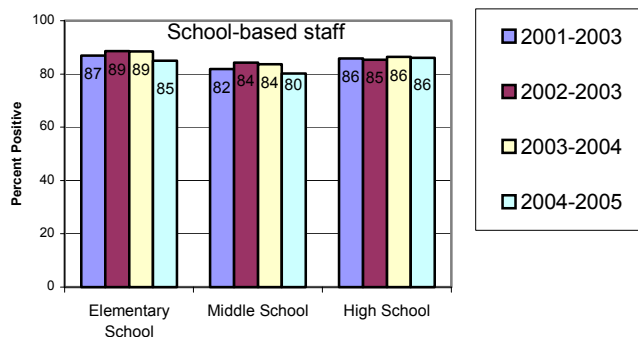


Figure 2. School-based staff by school-level positive perceptions of Job Satisfaction.

For *Goal 4: Create a Positive Work Environment in a Self-renewing Organization*, the SSE responds to the milestone: *The work environment promotes employee well-being, satisfaction, and positive morale*. Figure 2 shows the job satisfaction of MCPS employees. The data points show that the positive perceptions are all at or above 80%.

Discussion and Recommendations

Elementary schools continue to have the highest response rate on the surveys for all three groups, parents, students, and staff. The majority of elementary school districtwide Broad Areas positive perceptions are over 75% for parents, students and staff, with Physical Environment being the lowest. Parents in middle and high schools also have positive perceptions over 75% for the majority of Broad Areas; Partnerships was the only exception. Partnerships is the Broad Area students in middle and high schools responded to with the highest positive perception. Physical Environment had the lowest positive perception for students in elementary, middle, and high schools. For staff in all three levels, Job Satisfaction remains among the highest of the Broad Areas.

Elementary school districtwide groups have shown no statistically significant increases from last year. Only two Broad Areas had a statistically significant drop from last year, and have shown a 3-year declining trend—staff Social Environment and staff Job Satisfaction. Districtwide middle schools had only one statistically significant drop from last year—staff Job Satisfaction. Middle school parents had three Broad Areas that had a significant increase from last year in addition to showing a 3-year increasing trend—Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, and Satisfaction. With the exception of Partnerships, all high school Broad Areas for parents and students showed a statistically significant increase from last year. High school parents had four Broad Areas that had significant increases from last year as well as a 3-year increasing trend—Academic Environment, School Atmosphere and Communication, Social Environment, and Satisfaction. For students, Academic Environment, Social Environment, and Satisfaction all had a statistically significant increase from last year, with an increasing 3-year trend.

A survey work group with representatives from MCPS schools, offices, employee unions, and community organizations was formed to review the SSE and recommend changes, with a particular focus on increasing response rates and better meeting the reporting needs of MCPS and the community. During spring 2005, DSA met several times with the survey work group as well as the Shared Accountability Advisory Committee to review and propose changes to the SSE. Survey revisions include the addition of a Safe and Drug-Free Schools category, with items pertaining to teasing, bullying, and alcohol and drug use, to address the reporting requirements of the MCPS Strategic Plan.

In order to increase response rates, DSA has proposed shortening the survey for the 2005–2006 administration. In addition, Candlewood Elementary School and Hoover Middle School volunteered to pilot a computer-based version of the survey for their students in 2004–2005. The Web-based student survey was administered with ease for both students and administering staff. DSA has proposed giving all elementary and middle schools the option to use the online version rather than the paper version of the survey. DSA recommends continued meetings during fall 2005 with Special Schools and Alternative Programs work group members to develop a parent survey that better meets the needs of their schools and communities.

Appendix A

Decision Rules for Reporting School-Level Data

Parent Surveys

1. Rank by median number of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
2. Rank by median percentage of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
3. For the remaining schools that have not been reported—
 - a. If the number of completed surveys is greater than or equal to 30, a chi-square analysis on race/ethnicity (with a significance level of 0.10) is performed. If the test is significant, indicating that there is a difference between the sample and the population, the results are not reported.
 - b. If the number of completed surveys is less than 30, results are not reported.

Student Surveys

1. Any school with a response rate of less than 50% is not reported, since that is evidence of uneven administration at the school; i.e., not all students had an opportunity to complete the survey.

Staff Surveys

1. Rank by median number of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
2. Rank by median percentage of respondents by school level; top 50% are reported.
3. For the remaining schools that have not been reported, if the number of completed surveys is 30 or more, a chi-square analysis is performed on staff job classification and on years of service (less than 3 years and greater than 3 years), with a significance level of 0.10. If the chi-square test is significant, indicating that there is a difference between the sample and the population, the results are not reported.

Appendix B Elementary School Results Across Years

This appendix contains parent and student survey results and response rates for elementary schools. Positive perceptions of Broad Areas are shown for schools with adequate response rates. Schools without adequate response rates for reporting have “n/a” listed for that year.

East Silver Spring, Montgomery Knolls, New Hampshire Estates, Rosemary Hills, and Takoma Park elementary schools have no student data because they have no Grade 3 or Grade 5 students enrolled.
