

# Parking Lot

The **Parking Lot** technique is commonly used as a summative evaluation after a lesson or meeting. It incorporates the plus/delta strategy with a questions and future ideas component.

*Example:* Feedback from Baldrige Workshop

<h2>What's working?</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ The information was valuable.</li><li>▪ We were able to spend time planning.</li><li>▪ The strategies can be used immediately.</li><li>▪ The pacing was excellent.</li><li>▪ We don't feel overwhelmed!</li></ul>	<h2>What questions do you have?</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Will this take away from instructional time?</li><li>▪ What are the expectations?</li></ul>
<h2>What are the next steps?</h2> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Leadership team will determine scope and sequence for implementation.</li><li>▪ Teams will reach consensus.</li><li>▪ Volunteers will make poster templates.</li><li>▪ Staff development time will be used for more training.</li></ul>	<h2>Ideas</h2> <p>(Additions, deletions, and/or modifications?)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Model the mission statement lesson.</li><li>▪ Choose three quality tools to focus on.</li></ul>
