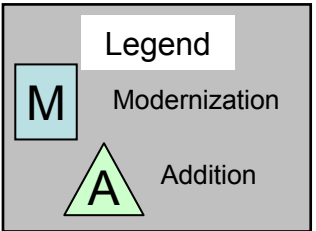

Seven Locks ES M A</p>	<p>4 March 2002 FY03-08 CIP</p> <p>Council action:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Defer modernization of Seven Locks ES to 2010 •Separate capacity projects (additions) from modernizations, even though this is more costly. <p>A Seven Locks ES becomes a 2-phase project – Add 8 rooms by Sept. 2006</p> <p>M Modernization by Sept. 2010</p>
<p>5 July 2002</p> <p>Feasibility plan for Seven Locks ES 2-phase project</p>	<p>6 May 2003</p> <p>Council votes to affirm March 2002 2-phase project with addition to be completed in 2006 and modernization to be completed in 2010. The addition to Seven Locks ES is increased to 10 rooms with gym</p>	<p>7 Fall/Winter 2003</p> <p>County Executive and Council PHED Committee request consideration of surplus Board of Education sites not needed for educational purposes, including Kendale</p>	<p>8 May 2004 FY05-10 CIP</p> <p>County Council approves plan to build Seven Locks ES replacement at Kendale site by 2007.</p> <p>Reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Safety – traffic issues •Lower costs •No holding school •Concern for students with construction onsite •Completed sooner – 2007 v. 2010 •Reuse of Seven Locks site to generate revenue
			<p>9 May 2005</p> <p>Council affirms the May 2004 decision based on Council staff recommendations.</p>
