Subject: Update on Title I Enrollment Option

This week, parents withdrew 17 applications from the Title I Enrollment Option. Altogether, there are now just 102 students from among more than 6,000 students enrolled in the 10 participating schools who have applied for the option, reflecting less than 2 percent of the students in these schools. Only five applications are from among the priority population of low performing, low income students. In one school, Broad Acres Elementary, none of the students are participating. Several other schools have similarly low participation data. Further reductions are anticipated when parents are asked later this summer to confirm their child's placement at the receiving schools.

I will keep you informed.
