WHEREAS, Bill 12-99, Closed Schools - Disposition, sponsored by Councilmember Blair G. Ewing, was introduced before the County Council on April 20, 1999; and

WHEREAS, On September 22, 1998, the Board of Education adopted a resolution that stated, "That the Board of Education strongly supports the views contained in a draft letter developed by the Superintendent, specifically that former public school buildings not presently in use as schools, should not be sold but, instead, leased upon the condition that they can, when needed for public education, be retrieved for that use;" and

WHEREAS, The proposed Bill provides the desired protection by requiring assurance from

the Board of Education before a surplus school is disposed of; now therefore be it

Resolved, That the Board of Education support County Council Bill 12-99, Closed Schools - Disposition, drafted and introduced by Councilmember Blair G. Ewing, that establishes a process for disposition of closed schools as meeting the intent and purpose of the Board's resolution of September 22, 1998, to protect the eventual retrieval of closed and surplus schools if needed for public education purposes; and be it further

<u>Resolved</u>, That a copy of this resolution be sent to the county executive and County Council.
