The hearing ended at 8:50 p.m.

- 1. Mr. Kauffman asked for the cost to fully implement hours-based staffing model at all middle schools for this year.
- 2. Mr. Kauffman asked for the dollar figure for the backlog of maintenance requests. (Number of work orders and requests filled.)
- 3. Ms. Berthiaume inquired if there were any budgetary barriers to making the Curriculum 2.0 kindergarten and Grade 1 available on line for parents.
- 4. Ms. Berthiaume asked for the cost of the middle years program in the Watkins Mill Cluster. Is there a grant or foundation money available?
- 5. Ms. Berthiaume asked if there would be a budget impact to allowing middle school reform courses to be offered in non-middle school reform schools.
- 6. Ms. Berthiaume asked for information on copier service calls and the average days copiers are out of service. Please update the old list.
- 7. Ms. Berthiaume inquired about the cost for a refrigerator for Flower Hill Elementary School.
- 8. Ms. Brandman asked if the lack of a refrigerator at Flower Hill stood in the way of them providing Maryland Meals for Achievement.
